REPORT OF THE ADVISORY COMMITTEE FOR RESERVE BANK DIRECTOR SELECTION

Recommended Candidates for the 2025 Election of Directors of the Federal Reserve Bank of Minneapolis

To All Member Banks in the Ninth Federal Reserve District:

The <u>Advisory Committee for Reserve Bank Director Selection</u> recently conferred to recommend candidates for consideration by member banks in nominating and electing directors of the Federal Reserve Bank of Minneapolis. The Advisory Committee is independent of the Board of Directors and consists of representatives recommended by banking associations from each of the states in the District.

The Advisory Committee itself cannot make nominations; its recommendations are advisory only. All nominations must be made by member banks in Groups 2 and 3. It is not the Advisory Committee's intention to preclude any Group 2 or 3 member bank from making its own nomination, as permitted, under the Federal Reserve Act. The nomination circular and process are posted on the <u>Director Election</u> webpage for viewing by all and nominating by Group 2 and 3 member banks that are eligible to participate in this election.
