**Neel Kashkari** [cash-CAR-ee] is president of the Federal Reserve Bank of Minneapolis, one of the Fed's 12 regional banks. The Minneapolis Fed serves the public by pursuing a growing economy that works for all of us, and the Bank's district includes Minnesota, the Dakotas, Montana, northwestern Wisconsin, and the Upper Peninsula of Michigan. Neel serves as a voting member on the Federal Open Market Committee, which sets the nation's monetary policy.

Neel began his career as an aerospace engineer developing technology for NASA space missions. He later held a variety of roles in public service and finance, most notably as assistant secretary of the Treasury during the 2008 financial crisis, where he oversaw the Troubled Asset Relief Program (TARP).

Neel and his wife, Christine, have two children, Uly and Tecumseh, and a Newfoundland dog named Webster.
