

The Minnesota Economic Association (MEA) Announces the Annual

UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT PAPER CONTEST

The competition is open to students who complete their submission while an undergraduate enrolled in a Minnesota or Wisconsin college or university. There are three categories:

Senior Thesis: an original research paper written as the culmination of a student's senior year

Term Paper: an original research paper written as part of a course or the culmination of a term

Economic Communication: This category is distinct from the Thesis and Term categories in that submissions need not be in the form of original written research. Submissions may take the form of a written blog, audio podcast, poster (submitted electronically) or video communicating important and timely economic phenomena; description of new and important research (by others); or policy papers based on the research of others.

A prize of \$300 is awarded for the first-place paper, \$200 for the second-place paper, and \$100 for the thirdplace paper in each category.

All entrants will receive free registration to the 2019 MEA Annual Conference which will be held on October 25, 2019 at Hamline University.

Entry Deadline: Friday, June 14, 2019

CONTEST REQUIREMENTS

- 1. The cover page should include the student's name, email address, school and the title of the paper. Avoid the use of identifying information on any page other than the title page.
- 2. The faculty sponsor should submit a cover email including his or her name, telephone number and email.
- 3. Entries should be sent in PDF format to <u>meacontest@macalester.edu</u>.
