

- How Are Those Opportunities Associated with Early Elementary School Outcomes?



- Analysis:
 - Investigate Student Attrition
 - Heterogeneity: e.g., by Maternal Education
 - Use Census Tract of Residence at Time of Birth
 - Matching with Multiple Treatments?
 - Examine Policy Changes (e.g. Head Start/Pre-K Coordination in 2014)
