The Bank of Cherokee County was founded in 1907, the year Indian Territory and Oklahoma Territory united as the State of Oklahoma, by a group of prominent members of the Cherokee tribe. In 1996 the ownership of the bank changed only for the fourth time in its history when another group of prominent members of the Cherokee tribe, headed by Gary D. Chapman, acquired the bank.
